MEN'S GROUP

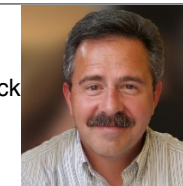
The Men's Group next meeting will be Monday November 26 - 6:30 pm at Dis & Dem. All men are invited. Come meet other men at the church.
